This modern and attractive complex is designed to achieve total harmony with its immediate environment as it is surrounded by vineyards and forests on the outskirts of Bordeaux.


The contemporary atmosphere, accented with recycled structures and materials, enhances the hotel's wine-country lifestyle.


In this enchanting environment, where the landscape is sculpted by the vines, the entire hotel reflects the character of southwest France.







Vinothérapie Spa


The Caudalie Vinotherapie Spa is based on a pioneering concept created a decade ago, combining the benefits of naturally warm spring water (from a well over 540 metres deep) with those of vines and grapes.

The refined atmosphere of the booths, the elegant blend of noble materials such as wood and stone, and an architecture reminiscent of traditional tobacco-drying barns, combine to create a perfect harmony with the surrounding vineyard landscape, giving the relaxation and treatment areas a special cachet.
